



# Zanzibar, Tanzania Summer 2016

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This five-week program will explore the unique history, culture, and religion of the Zanzibar people. It will give students an opportunity to interact with the local communities as they sharpen their language skills and learn the chronology of events that shaped the Swahili language, religions and ways of life.

## LOCATION DESCRIPTION

Students will visit the ancient ruins of Stone Town, the famous prison island, and spice plantations. They will also swim with dolphins, taste the local cuisine in the moonlight, attend the Zanzibar International Film Festival, and go on a safari.

## HOUSING

Student accommodations will be in a rented town house in Stone Town, fenced and guarded, with wifi and laundry facilities, and an amazing view of Zanzibar.
